On-Field Activities

The Windy City ThunderBolts are happy to reopen Ozinga Field under the “Phase 3” guidelines the State of Illinois put forth in their “Restore Illinois” Plan.

The ThunderBolts are going to follow State guidelines to ensure everyone entering the facility will have a safe and enjoyable experience during their visit.

Baseball Activities Permitted

- Drills, practices, and lessons that do not involve contact between individuals
- All on-field participants must allow for 6-ft of social distancing at all times

Baseball Activities NOT Permitted

- Competitive games of any kind
(regular season, tournament, practice, scrimmage or simulation games)

Participation Attendance Regulations

- Group sizes should be limited to 10 participants or fewer per every one coach
- If team has more than 10 participants, multiple groups are permitted, however groups must be separated by 30-ft of distance at all times. Groups may not mix with each other. Please stay in your group.

Turf Field Regulations

- Metal cleats/spikes are NOT allowed on the field
- Turf shoes and molded spikes are allowed
- Seeds and gum of any kind are not allowed anywhere inside the stadium.

Facilities Amenities

- Batting cage and all on-field protective nets and screens will be available for use including portable hitting turtle, L-screen, pitching platform, and other field screens.
- Dugouts will be closed at all times
- One set of restrooms will be open on outer concourse behind home plate
- All other facilities including all locker rooms and press area will be closed

On-Field Safety

Face Covering Regulations

Participants NEED to wear face coverings over their nose & mouth when not on the field.

On-field participants must use face covering when:

- Entering or exiting our facility
- Entering or exiting the field
 - Inside our restrooms
 - Walking the concourse
- Anytime you cannot be socially distance from others (6-ft away)

On-Field Safety Regulations

- Participants must bring their own source of water/sports drink. All water fountains in the facility will be unavailable.
 - No handshakes at the beginning or end of practice
 - Participants should sanitize hands regularly. Various hand sanitizer stations will be available around the facility however we encourage everyone to bring their own personal hand sanitizer
 - While protective netting will be available, participants should avoid touching this baseball equipment as much as possible
 - Participants should use their own equipment (e.g., helmet, bat, gloves)
 - The dugouts will be closed. Participants must place personal belongings at least 6-ft. away from others' personal belongings

Spectators

Spectators are not encouraged unless required for parental supervision or if non-household members are able to social distance from participants and from one another.

Spectator amenities will be limited to one restroom.

- Concessions will be closed and no outside food or drinks (including seeds & peanuts) are allowed in the park with the exception of rehydration drinks for participants.

ALL Spectators NEED to wear face coverings over their nose & mouth when:

- Entering or exiting our facility
 - Inside our restrooms
 - Walking the concourse
- Anytime you cannot be socially distance from other (6-ft away)
