On-Field Activities

The Windy City ThunderBolts are continuing to operate Ozinga Field under the “Phase 4” guidelines the State of Illinois put forth in their “Restore Illinois” Plan.

The ThunderBolts are going to follow State guidelines to ensure everyone entering the facility will have a safe and enjoyable experience during their visit.

Baseball Activities Permitted

- All types of baseball activities, including competitive games, are now permitted

Participation Attendance Regulations

- Total on-field participation (players, coaches & officials) are limited to 50 participants

Turf Field Regulations

- Metal cleats/spikes are NOT allowed on the field
 - Turf shoes and molded spikes are allowed
- Seeds and gum of any kind are not allowed anywhere inside the stadium.

Facilities Amenities

- Batting cage and dugouts are open for use
- One set of restrooms will be open on outer concourse behind home plate
 - All locker rooms facilities will remain closed
 - The playground area will remain closed

On-Field Safety

Face Covering Regulations

Participants should wear face coverings over their nose & mouth when not on the field.

On-field participants should use face covering when:

- Entering or exiting our facility
- Entering or exiting the field
 - Inside our restrooms
 - Walking the concourse
- Anytime you cannot be socially distance from others (6-ft away)

On-Field Safety Regulations

- Participants should bring their own source of water/sports drink. All water fountains in the facility will be unavailable.
 - No handshakes at the beginning or end of event
- Participants should sanitize hands regularly. Various hand sanitizer stations will be available around the facility however we encourage everyone to bring their own personal hand sanitizer
- Participants should use their own equipment (e.g., helmet, bat, gloves)

Spectators

Spectators are welcome at Ozinga Field. State of Illinois mandates a capacity limit of no more than 20% of our normal general seating capacity. No more than 500 guests will be allowed inside the stadium at any one time.

- Spectator amenities will be limited to one restroom.
- Very limited concessions, including alcohol beverages, will be available at select events.
- Guests are allowed to bring in outside food and drinks with the EXCEPT seeds & peanuts.

ALL Spectators should wear face coverings over their nose & mouth when:

- Entering or exiting our facility
 - Inside our restrooms
 - Walking the concourse
- Anytime you cannot be socially distance from other (6-ft away)
